Since retiring from the federal government in 2004, Bill has been a volunteer with a number of organizations. Currently, he coordinates a Restorative Justice Program for the Northern Virginia Mediation Service, which offers an alternative to typical punishment sanctions in the Fairfax County, Virginia, schools and juvenile court.

Bill has been mediating disputes in the federal government since 2000, and he has been certified to mediate in the Virginia General District Court since 2006.

He is a leader of the local affiliate of Voice of the Faithful and completed a six-year term on its national board in 2012.

Bill and his wife Kris live in Alexandria, Virginia, and are active in a number of ministries in their Catholic parish.

Bill worked for 34 years in management and executive positions in the federal government. He received his bachelor's degree from Villanova University, a master's degree in theology from Augustinian College, and a master's degree in public administration from the University of Southern California.
