More than ever, your parish relies on the involvement of all the laity. Join a ministry, volunteer for a committee, share your time and talents.

**2**  
**PROTECT CHILDREN  
IN YOUR PARISH**

Does your parish have a Safe Environment training program and monitoring committee? If not, perhaps you can start one.

**3**  
**REACH OUT TO  
SURVIVORS OF ABUSE**

Get together with fellow parishioners to plan repentance services and healing services for survivors.

**4**  
**SUPPORT YOUR PRIESTS  
OF INTEGRITY**

Work to help our priests of integrity in any way you can. Look for ways to share their workload.

**5**  
**SEEK ACCOUNTABILITY  
IN CHURCH LEADERS**

Bishops who transferred known abusers should examine their consciences and, where appropriate, step down for the good of the Church.

**6**  
**PROMOTE LAY INVOLVEMENT  
IN THE SELECTION OF BISHOPS**

It is time to revive a long tradition in the Church of lay involvement in the selection of a new bishop.

**7**  
**STUDY THE CAUSES  
OF THE CURRENT CRISIS**

Every thinking Catholic needs to be informed about the causes of the sex abuse scandal, so that it can never happen again.

**SUPPORT A CHURCH-WIDE  
INVESTIGATION OF ABUSE**

News reports have already uncovered major problems in the U.S., Canada, Australia, Ireland, Germany, Austria, the Netherlands, Italy and elsewhere. The Church needs to conduct a survey of the problem in every country worldwide.

**WORK FOR FINANCIAL  
TRANSPARENCY**

The scandal has cost the Catholic Church more than \$2.5 billion in the U.S. alone. Management of Church finances at the parish and diocesan levels needs to be open and transparent, with active lay involvement.

**LET YOUR VOICE  
BE HEARD**

People are already calling for a new global council to address the many problems we face. Be sure your voice is heard in the great global conversation now beginning.
